Here's how much car you can afford Follow the 35% rule. Whether you're paying cash, leasing, or financing a car, your upper spending limit really shouldn't be a penny more than 35% of your gross annual income. That means if you make \$36,000 a year, the car price shouldn't exceed \$12,600.
